A clean-lined interpretation of an ancient form, this tapered basin was hand-carved by artisans in China's Shandong province. The basin looks meticulously painted, but the mesmerizing pattern of the puddingstone is inherent to the stone, a material quarried in the Liaoning region of China and prized by scholars for its exceptional patterning.
