Chiseled from a block of granite over a century ago, the sculptural trough charms with its uneven surface, textured interior, and asymmetrical contours. Recently drilled at the base with a small drainage hole, the trough makes a wonderful planter, perfect for hens-and-chicks and other lush succulents.
