This early 20th century breezeway tile has a simple floral lattice design with cloud-like ruyi symbols at each corner. A beautiful turquoise-green glaze cloaks the exterior, textured by crazing, blisters, and iron leaching for wabi-sabi appeal. Much like wooden lattice panels, perforated ceramic tiles such as this were used to allow light and air to flow through the walled courtyards of Qing-dynasty homes, schools, and temples. Today, these tiles add rich color to modern interiors as a wall sculptures, trivets, or chargers.
