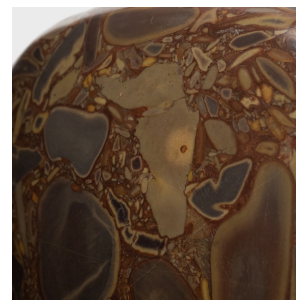
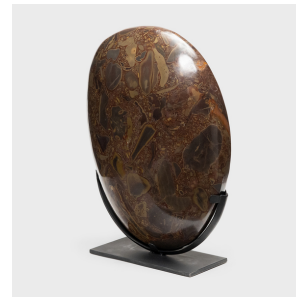
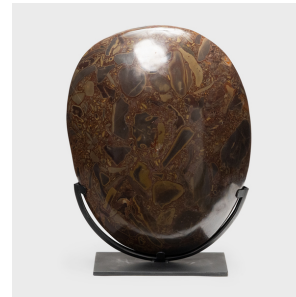

Puddingstone is named for its unique composite nature, a suspension of multicolored pebbles that resemble raisins in a pudding. Historically, the unusual stone was favored by scholar-artists and calligraphers as an ideal surface on which to place scrolls for painting.

This stunning puddingstone specimen was formed in China's Shandong province many thousands of years ago and has been shaped by hand into a smooth oval to reveal its distinctive markings. Continued...
