The stool rests on four short cabriole legs ending in dainty whorl feet, embellished with simple acanthus leaves and six-petal flowers. The curved apron is carved with graceful parallel lines, a motif echoed in the carved legs and upholstery trim. The rectangular top has been recently updated with black-and-white wool upholstery for a neutral and modern finish.
