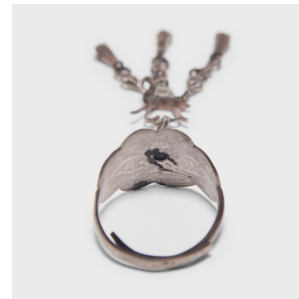

From the ring hangs a thin chain with a forked, tassel-like end.
