Drawing on a long Chinese tradition of monochrome ceramics, this striking long-necked vase is cloaked in an all-over milky white glaze. Sculpted by artisans in China's Zhejiang province, the vase reinterprets a traditional gooseneck shape known as a "celestial ball vase" with clean lines and an understated sculptural presence. The striking white glaze nods to the Song dynasty (960–1279) when tastes shifted to monochrome glazes in single, statement-making colors.

Each jar is hand-made. Dimensions vary slightly.
